## **REACH – Publication REACH 11**

Dear Sir, dear Madame,

Our last publication on the subject of REACH dates from September 2022. Due to multiple requests for the current status of the ECHA Candidate List of substances of very high concern for Authorisation, we are publishing an update.

We have an implemented, as well as certified, corporate management system according to the standards ISO 9001, EN 9100, ISO 14001 and ISO 50001. Here alone, we have committed ourselves to evaluate and comply with legal obligations.

Therefore, we will of course continue to meet applicable REACH Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 (REACH). In particular, we check the ECHA Candidate SVHC List regularly.\*

Based on this list (as of January 2023), we can reassure you that no material with more than the maximum allowable concentration is present in our products.

Our central REACH contact persons have been designated. You can reach them under REACH.TEAM@ALUNNATUBES.com. As before, we ask you to refrain from sending us questionnaires or similar. This request to complete these still cannot be met by us.

Under www.alunnatubes.com we offer an information portal where updated information specific to the REACH topic can be found. This covers all important information.

Should a substance be included in the ECHA Candidate SVHC List\* which occurs in our products with more than the permitted concentration, we will issue a new release!

We will keep our website updated too. It is worth visiting not only because of REACH.
